Winemaker Notes: The cooler temperatures and lack of heat spikes throughout the 2019 growing season contributed to excellent flavor development and acid retention in the grapes. This resulted in refined wines with captivating aromatics and notable character. Inspired by some of Australia's renowned blends, we meticulously combined soft, lush Syrah, firmly structured Cabernet Sauvignon, deeply colored Malbec, and aromatic Cabernet Franc to craft a complex and memorable wine. Aged in 50% new French oak barrels for enhanced structure and complexity, this wine stands out as one of the premier blends of the vintage.
