Winemaker Notes: Named for our youngest son, the name Sewell means "mighty at sea." To live up to this name, we needed a bold and unique blend. We're not sure if Super Rioja's exist in the same way as Super Tuscans, but, if they do not, we decided to sail into uncharted waters. With this in mind, we took our soft, earthy Tempranillo and added portions of big, jammy Syrah, structured Cabernet Sauvignon, and just a touch of our dark, dense Petite Sirah. This wine is mighty indeed.
