Winemaker Notes: The 2016 vintage began remarkably hot in the spring but cooled off by summer. This extended hang time allowed for both gradual and even ripening - perfect weather for developing ripe flavors at moderate sugars. Our Tempranillo is a very small, limited production wine that was crafted carefully to respect the interesting, unique flavors this varietal has to offer.

Tasting Notes: Aged in French oak, our Tempranillo is earthy and soft with interweaving notes of blackberry, cedar, and dried herbs.
